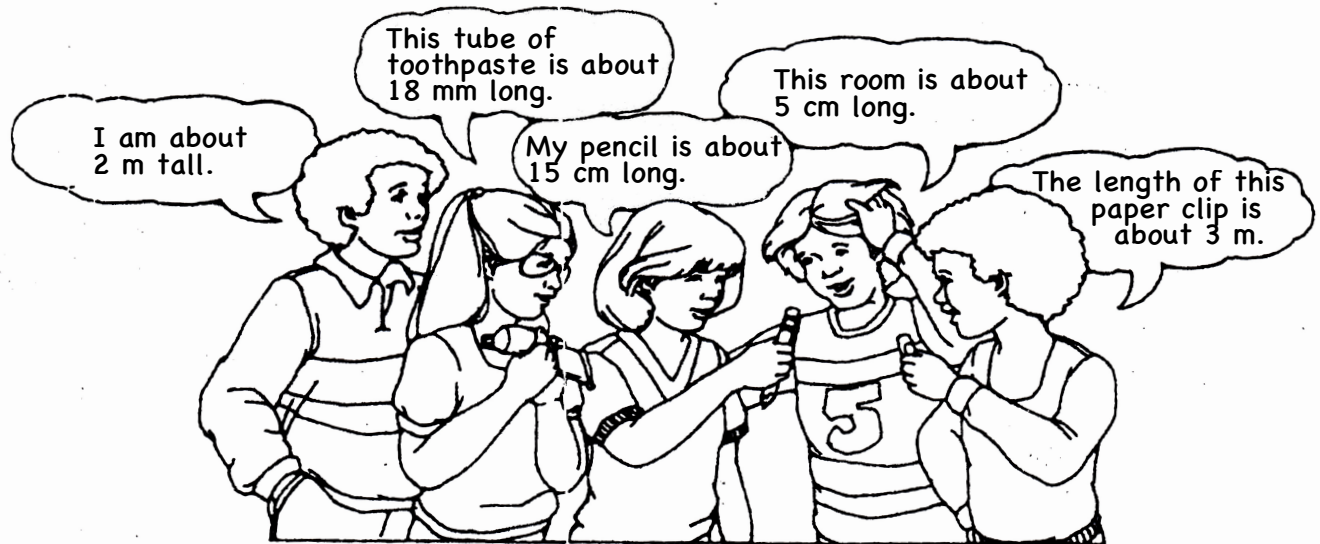


Choose the Best Metric Unit
