

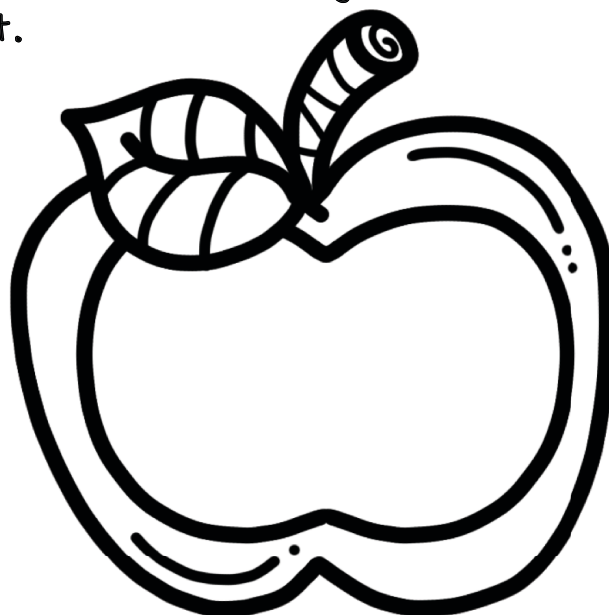

# How Many Apples?

As part of his math class, Ernie must figure out how many apples were picked at Tipton's Apple Orchard this year. His teacher gave him clues to figure out the answer. Read the clues to figure out what digit is in each place value spot.

1. The digit four was not in the ten thousands or ones place.
2. The digit in the hundreds place is either a 6 or a 1.
3. Ernie had to solve this problem to figure out the digit in the tens place:  $(235 - 128) - 101 = \underline{\quad}$
4. Ernie had to solve this problem to figure out the digit in the ones place:  $(321 + 258) - 577 = \underline{\quad}$
